METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,002 GB adults by telephone between 8th and 10th April 2016. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all GB adults. Data were also weighted by past vote recall. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
